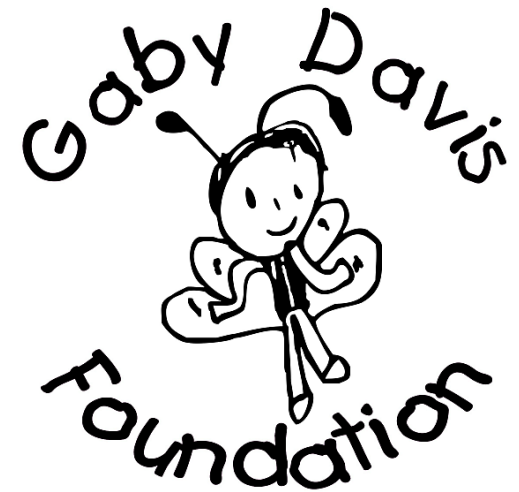

Where We Began

Gaby was a healthy, happy, spirited 6 year old before our family was faced with her cancer diagnosis.

It took 4 long months with many trips to doctors and hospitals before the discovery was made. Gaby was unable to breathe through her nose and breathing through her mouth was laboured so she was put into ICU and was given a tracheostomy to help her breathe. The cancer, Embryonal Rhabdomyosarcoma, was growing in behind her eye, in her sinuses and out of her right ear. She spent a month in ICU getting weekly chemotherapy treatments before the tumour was small enough for her to breathe well enough for her trache to be removed so she could come home. That wasn't the end though; she needed 40 more weeks of chemo as well as 30 rounds of radiation.

During Gaby's fight, it was necessary for one of us to leave our employment for the course of her 44 week treatment. It was also necessary for Gaby to travel to Loma Linda, California for 7 weeks in order to receive specialized proton radiation treatment for her cancer. There were many costs that were not covered by insurance and we were required to carry two households during her time away.

We made countless trips to the hospital for chemotherapy, transfusions, fever scares and overnight chemotherapy visits. In January 2007, an MRI confirmed the tumour was gone and we were quite hopeful she would make a full recovery.

Through it all, Gaby remained positive and cheerful. Determined to continue to live life to the fullest each and everyday, even when she was confined to bed. She often thought of the other children who were facing the same or similar circumstances and wondered what she could do to help them through the difficult times.

In February 2007 Gaby started experiencing flu like symptoms and on a regular hospital visit for chemo we noticed some paralysis in her face. Soon after, it was confirmed that the cancer was back and had spread into her brain and spinal fluid. The prognosis was not good and sadly we lost Gaby to the cancer shortly after the relapse was discovered.

Gaby's Wish

In the summer of 2007 we started the "Gaby Davis Foundation" in memory our daughter and friend Gabrielle Davis who lost her battle with childhood cancer in March 2007.

Her brave fight against cancer and her thoughtfulness towards other children with cancer inspired us to help other families fighting this terrible beast.

During one of Gaby's treatment days Gaby and her Dad went to the hospital pharmacy to pick up her required medication. It was then that they witnessed another parent trying to get the medications needed to bring their child home from the hospital. This family did not have enough money to pay for the medication and the parent was quite distraught. After Gaby and Dad left the pharmacy she turned to her Dad and said:

"Dad, we sure are lucky to have so many friends helping us.

You think when my cancer is over, we can help people who don't have as many friends?

I wish all the kids with cancer had enough money to do the stuff we get to do."

Please help us make Gaby's wish come true.

Gaby wouldn't have wanted it any other way.
